


Location

Bedrooms all have bunk beds and range in size from 2 to 10 beds.









Call system

All dormitories have a call button if the children need help or reassurance during the night.







AT NIGHT...

- SECURITY IS PARAMOUNT
- There is always at least one male and one female member of Robinwood staff awake and on duty during the night. Members of staff will be allocated rooms near to the children. The building is always secured overnight.
- Emergency call button in every room.
- School staff also located on each dorm level usually right next door - so be warned we don't want grumpy teachers due to lack of sleep!
- Mrs Lindley will be contacted in the event of an emergency and will in turn contact parents.





Catering

We will be given a set time for our meals and will eat together.

The children are very well catered for and there is no need to provide any extra snacks.

As well as toast and cereals a cooked breakfast is always provided.

Lunch typically comprises of wraps, sandwiches, fruits and yogurts.

Hot meals in the evening could be pasta bolognese, pizza or curry.

Break time snacks are provided and additional fruit is always available.


There is always a vegetarian option and dietary requirements such as gluten / dairy free, Halal or coeliac are catered for.

Health & Safety

Robinwood has an excellent safety record over 25 years of operation and currently more than 40,000 visiting pupils each year.

All instructors are fully qualified, DBS checked and first aid trained.

Robinwood has Public Liability Insurance.

All risk assessments have been submitted to the Local Authority for approval.



Medication/money

- All medication, including inhalers, MUST be handed to Mrs Esson on the morning of departure.
- It should be clearly labelled with your child's name and the dosage/ frequency of the medication.
- Any over the counter medicine must be specified on your consent form. E.g. Calpol, travel sickness tablets and provided, fully labelled as above.
- We will contact you if we feel it is necessary to administer for verbal permission.
- Children do not need any money at all there is no gift shop!







There is no need to go out and buy anything special for a trip to Robinwood, all specialist equipment is provided.

The clothing list given includes clothing being worn on the journey (so if you are wearing a pair of trousers for the journey, you only need to pack 2 more pairs).

Jeans are not suitable for the activities as they are restrictive and uncomfortable when wet – joggers and tracksuit bottoms are much better.

Everything MUST be clearly labelled.

Due to the nature of the activities, it is possible that clothes may occasionally get damaged. All clothing should be suitable for use in an outdoor, and sometimes muddy, environment.

Old clothes are best, not new or expensive clothing.



Kit list



- Refillable water bottle
- Comfortable long-sleeved tops (sweatshirts/jumpers/hoodies/fleeces)
- 3 T-shirts (no vests or crop tops)
- 3 Pairs of trousers (not restrictive; sportswear is good/ideally not jeans)
- 2 Pairs of shorts (knee length) or leggings you don't mind getting wet
- 5 Sets of underwear
- 6 Pairs of socks
- 2 Pairs of trainers
- 2 Towels
- 1 Waterproof coat
- Sunhat and sun cream
- 1 Set of nightwear
- 1 Bag of toiletries
- 1 Bin liner (for wet clothes on day 3)





Prohibited items

Any spray aerosols such as deodorant (roll-on ones please).

Money.


Mobile phones/ cameras/ valuable items.

The day of departure.....

- On the day of departure children should come to school at normal time and leave their luggage (which they must be able to carry themselves) in the friendship area.
- They should then come into the classroom as normal.
- Any medications should be handed to Mrs Esson at that point.





The day of return

- Children will be back from the centre at approximately 3.20pm
- You are welcome to come and collect them at that time – we will send a text message to tell you when we have set off with an approximate time of arrival.
- We are in school as normal on the Thursday after our return – however we won't be working too hard!!
