

# Langho and Billington St. Leonard's Church of England Primary School

Remote Learning 2021 - 22 Action Plan.

Whilst we hope that the majority of our children will have an uninterrupted experience this year, there is the possibility that individual children, will need to self-isolate for a period of time. This plan is therefore in place to ensure that all children can continue with their education should this occur.

## **Access to Learning**

The school will provide remote learning through the platforms outlined below. When school is notified before 8am, we will endeavour to upload and assign the learning that day. If school are notified after this then it may not be possible until after the end of the school day, due to teachers being in class.

If a child does not have access to a computer/laptop and/or the internet, the school will do all it can to support children and will provide devices on loan. <u>Parents will be reminded to make the school aware of any barriers to accessing remote learning.</u>

### Additional support for pupils with particular needs

We value that all children and situations are different. A child's Class Teacher along with other members of staff, will work with the family to provide additional support for children to access the learning and continue to make progress.

## Wellbeing and Communication

Should isolation need to continue for a prolonged period of time, such as during a partial school closure, parents will receive regular support phone calls, to see if their child is managing well with their learning and to check on their wellbeing. We will then be able to offer any additional support required. In these circumstances, teachers will track pupil's engagement across the curriculum and contact parents if an issue arises.

We will continue work and



to praise excellent achievements and

provide feedback to enable children to continue to make progress.

## Teaching and Learning

Teachers may use a combination of the following approaches to teach pupils remotely:

- recorded teaching (i.e. White Rose national or occasionally bespoke videos created by teachers)
- commercially available websites supporting the teaching of specific subjects or areas, including video clips or sequences, for example Spelling Shed
- Powerpoint presentations and google slides that present the knowledge and give opportunities for practice and application

#### Feedback

Feedback will be provided in line with our marking and feedback policy. Teachers will use knowledge of children's work to inform their planning and future lessons.

EYFS – Feedback will be via email and phone calls.

KS1 and KS2 -Children will receive comments (written or audio) on the respective learning platforms. Alternatively, work that children complete on paper should be kept safe and returned to school when safe to do so.

### Curriculum

We teach the same curriculum remotely as we do in school wherever possible and appropriate. However, we may need to make some adaptations in some subjects. For example, in PE or DT to reflect the restrictions of remote learning without the school space and equipment available.

In the event of an individual child testing positive for COVID 19 and needing to self isolate, the school will ensure communication of the necessary daily Remote Learning via email (EYFS), SeeSaw (KS1) and Google Classroom (KS2).

In the event of a full Bubble Closure or National Lockdown, you will find below an overview of lessons to be completed each day. We will provide learning across the curriculum and children will be expected to spend a similar amount of time completing this as they would spend learning in school.

## Blackbirds (Reception)

**Platform**: Seesaw. (Communication also via email)

Home Learning offers a range of learning across all seven areas of the Early Years' Curriculum throughout the week, with opportunities for Worship, Phonics, Maths and Story Time provided daily, following the long-term plan and using appropriate sources such as White Rose Maths, Phonics Play, Oxford Owl and Comics for Phonics. In addition to this, other curriculum learning and resources will be made available including ideas for play, relevant printable resources and useful/interesting links.

#### Mondays

Worship – activity to explore a Gospel value or Bible story

**Phonics** – Little Wandle phonics lessons as would be done in school

**Early writing** – using the literacy-led approach, to develop early writing skills (pre-recorded session)

**Phonicsplay** – activities selected from this website to accurately support children's phonics progression

Maths – pre-recorded sessions or White Rose resources

Story Time – quality shared story opportunities to promote key language and vocabulary skills.

#### **Tuesdays**

Worship – as above.

**Phonics** – as above.

**PSHE/PSED** - Question and activity, including drawing or reflection opportunity

Oxford Owl – selected reading books/texts to accurate match and support children's developing phonic decoding skills and fluency with reading. (parent log in)

Comics for Phonics – activities selected from this site to support early reading.

**Letter to children from class teachers** (sent via parents email) – supporting contact between home and school, maintaining secure links and reassurance.
