Although those from the most vulnerable and disadvantaged backgrounds have been hardest hit since the pandemic, it is clear this impact is not specific to just these pupils alone. The impact of lost time in education has been substantial, and school is working hard to ensure rapid progress for all children to catch up with learning at an age appropriate level across the full curriculum in school.

To support and consider the best use of these funds for our school, this plan has been developed in line with the EEF's 3-tiered approach:

- high-quality teaching, such as staff professional development
- providing targeted academic support, such as tutoring
- tackling non-academic barriers to academic success, such as difficulties with attendance, behaviour and social and emotional wellbeing

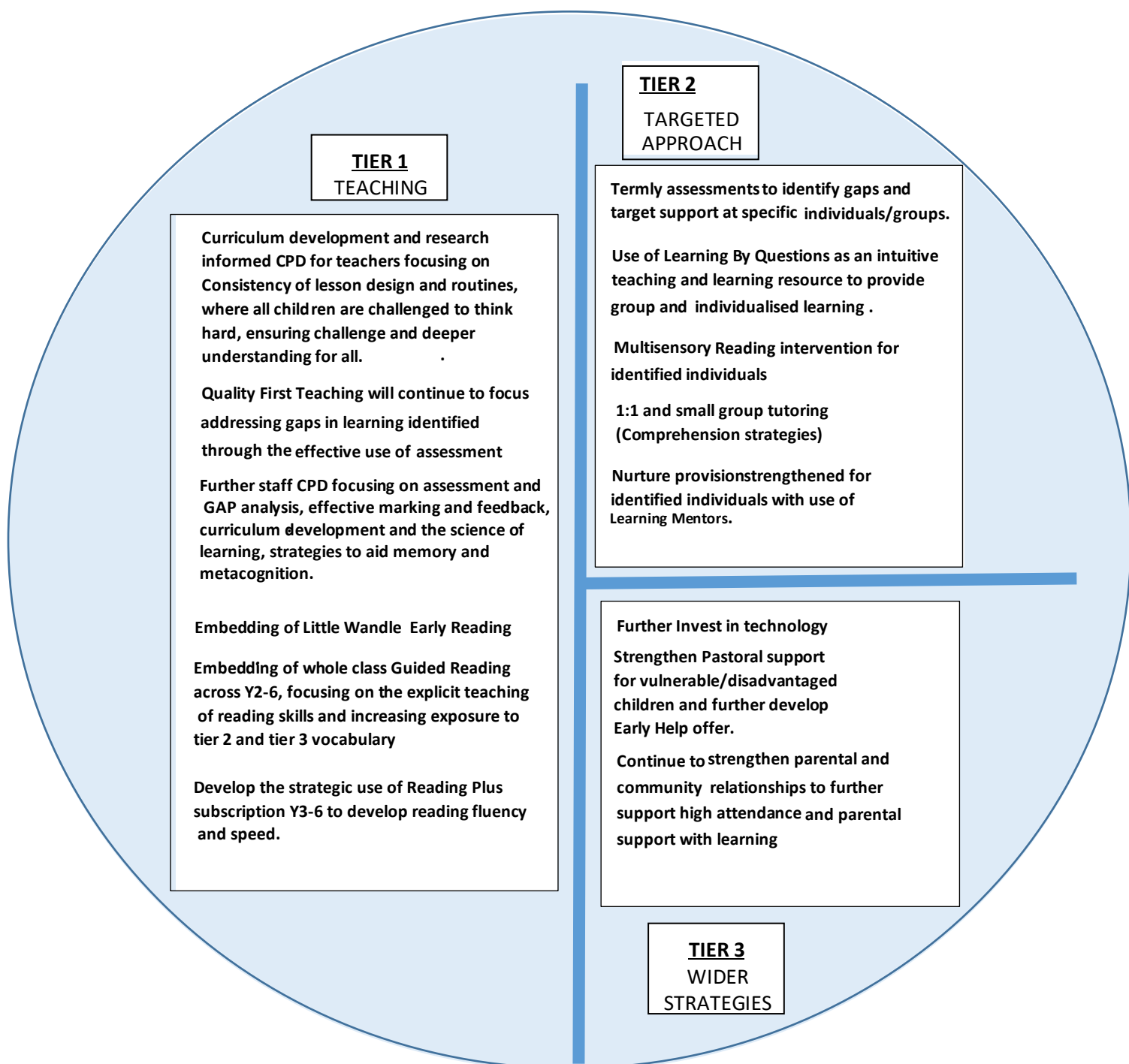
To determine the most effective use of these funds, school has undertaken further audit of the progress made towards recovering from the historical impact of Covid-19 upon our children and closing identified gaps since the pandemic. This has involved:

- self-evaluation of school's ability to engage in recovery, (based around the 4Rs, Routine, Relevance, Relationships and Reflections) which identifies barriers and actions to overcome them.
- Purchase curriculum resources and technology that allow for access and blended learning (between home and school)
- Provide ongoing support to children and parents.
- Curriculum development - implement actions to return children to a 'normal' curriculum as soon as possible.
- Strong focus on analysis of pupil progress information

The following diagram details the additional provision to be put in place, which will be funded by via Catch-up and Recovery Premium, and supplemented by funds from the General Annual Grant and school reserves.
